Categories:

JUNIORS

Junior swimmers are those who are born in 1999 to 2002. A women and / or men's team may consist of up to six participants.

SENIORS

For senior swimmers those who are born in 2001 or earlier. A women and / or men's team may consist of up to six participants.

MASTERS

For senior swimmers those who are born in 1987 or earlier. A women and / or men's team may consist of up to six participants.

In none of the categories are mixed teams allowed.

You can register at the Splash form (this is from October 2nd on the website available). This should be filled in and emailed as soon as possible but no later than November 11, 2017 to competition email address: redned.orangecup@gmail.com.

Participation

- For the Senior-Junior-Master category a national team or club can enroll one team in the open category, one team in the master category and one team in the junior who also participate in the relay events. Such a team consists of up to six men and six women. For individual athletes there is an unlimited enrollment.
- Athletes may participate in a maximum of five individual disciplines.

Classifications

The classification of the Orange Cup is formatted as follows:

- Individually there are medals per competition discipline
- For the teams prices will be counting the scores of the relays.

The ranking for the <u>National Championship</u> is formatted as follows:

- There is a ranking for Juniors, Seniors and Masters. Medals are per discipline, there is no overall counting.
- Only Dutch athletes qualify for this classification into account.

Registration Costs

To participate in this competition a registration fee of € 10,- needs to be paid per individual participant, transfer this registration fee to bank account NL64 INGB 0792 3981 73, Attn W.P.C. de Klerk, mentioning Orange Cup team and club name.

No later than four days before the race the entry fee must be credited to the account. If this is not the case, the team will be excluded from participation for the championship.
