#### Categories:

## **JUNIORS**

Junior are born between 1997 and 2000.

A women and / or men's team may consist of up to 6 participants. Participants must be a member of the National Society and/or an local Lifesaving club.

## **SENIORS**

Seniors are born in 1999 or earlier.

A women and / or men's team may consist of up to 6 participants. Participants must be a member of the National Society and/or an local Lifesaving club.

# MASTERS

Masters are born in 1985 or earlier.

A women and / or men's team may consist of up to 6 participants. Participants must be a member of the National Society and/or an local Lifesaving club.

## MIXED TEAMS

At the Masters any mixed team is allowed with the permission of the organization. With Juniors and Seniors no mixed teams are allowed.

You can register via the registration form. This should be send by email as soon as possible but no later than August 23th, 2015 to the email address: redned.nkocean@gmail.com.

More details on the competition are send to you after enrollment by a program brochure.

To participate in this competition is a registration fee of € 8, - (per participant for the whole event) has to be paid to bank account NL64 INGB 0792 3981 73 into the name of

Five days before the race, the entry fee must be credited to the account.

If this is not the case, the team may exclude from participation for the championship.

#### Information:

This national competition is organized for the 11th time. The event is also open to foreign teams. This means that foreign teams count in the competitions for the prices.

## **Accommodation**

The competition is held on the beach in Noordwijk (Koningin Wilhelmina Boulevard). At the venue is an opportunity for you change clothes and there are toilets. If needed there will accommodation available for the participants at the Leeuwenhorst hotel, rate 35 Euro per person/per night. If you are interested in it, please contact us by email, so we can help you further.

#### **Participation**

The competition is divided equally over two days with the European Championships IRB (Inflatable Rescue boats). Look carefully to the timetable on the website www.breedtesport.eu (time depends on sea and weather-conditions). Each society or club may subscribe an unlimited participants per team. The final order of the different disciplines are included in the program booklet.

On disciplines with a ski (ski race, ocean man / woman, ocean man / woman relay) only enroll of participants who have already completed a full race course at sea, is allowed. The team manager must sign for these participants a special statement. The final decision rests with the referee and the security officer of the local brigade.

# **Material**

Teams are requested to bring their own caps, boards and skis. Teams that do not have their own board, must send a request to hire this. In principle no ski's are available to hire. If that gives al large problem, please contact the organization. Send an e-mail as soon as possible but no later than August 23, 2015.

At registration is € 20, - deposit has to be paid and in return they receive a special card which the material can be collected.

## Recognition

Each team needs to be recognized during the race by means of a different color cap. The color is in principle free to choose, as long as the combination of color and pattern, is unique. See also lifesaving.nl/sport/club caps NL

## Scoring in series and semifinals

Every athlete (or team) receives one point per event for a right finish.. Example: After series, semi-finals and finals, the winner gets 23 points.

Registration/administration of the teams will start on Saturday at 8:00 hrs and Sunday at 9:00 hrs. On Saturday there will be an official Openings Ceremony for the EC IRB, where also the teams of the Ocean Competition will take part of. For that reason everybody has to be ready on Saturday at 8:30 hrs for the ceremony.
