General Information

Please follow the orders and guidelines of the volunteers of the organization. The start will be by whistle or claxon. The use of whistles in the swimming pool needs to be minimized. During the start procedure absolute silence will be requested/ is required.



TIME SCHEDULE:

Saturday

- 08.30: Registration of the teams at entree of Swimming complex
- 08.30: Referees/officials meeting
- 09.00 : Team Captain meeting / Training pool open for warming up. => No warming up in the competition pool!
- 09.30 : Start of the competition
- 18.00 : End of first competition day

<u>Sunday</u>

- 08.30 : Referees/officials meeting
- 09.00 Team Captain meeting / Training pool open for warming up => No warming up in the competition pool!
- 09.30 : Start of the competition
- 18.00 : End of the Orange Cup competition / Ceremonies for teams

Ceremonies will take place for the individual disciplines during the program in the KNZB room. The ceremony for the Orange Cup (team competition) will take place on Sunday in the swimming pool at the end of the event. Additional information regarding the ceremonies will be given during the team captains meeting.

During the championship, warming-up and cooling-down can only be done in the training swimming pool (4 lanes of 50 m) during the competition time.

COMPETITION RULES

Participation to this event is open for individual competitors and teams (National or Club) Categories:

<u>Junior</u>: born in period 2002 to 1999 and being at least 90 days member of the national society or club team.

<u>Senior</u>: born 2001 or earlier, and being at least 90 days member of the national society or club team. <u>Masters</u>: born in 1987 or earlier, and being at least 90 days member of the national society or club team.

PROTEST (according ILS Competition Rulebook)

Only the team manager may protest against a disqualification to the chief-referee, and subsequently dispute a chief-referee's decision. A protest against a competitor or a team or against a decision of an official must be lodged verbally with the chief-referee within 15 minutes of posting of the result of the event or within 15 minutes of being notified verbally by the referee of the decision, whichever occurs first.

If submitting a protest a fee of 20 Euro has to be paid. Based on the decision of the protest by the chief-referee, this fee will be paid back or become to the National Organization Committee. The decision of the chief referee shall be final, without the right of appeal.

PAYMENT

The registration fee need to be paid not later than **29 November** on the following account: Account name: CBS

If the payment is not fulfilled before 30-November-2017, no participation is allowed.

During the competition, the Dutch organisation will take care for the tubes, manikins, line throw ropes and obstacles.

During the event, the latest version of the ILS Competition Rule Book is applicable.





Subscription, adding's or changing in the disciplines to participate is only possible before <u>26 november 2017.</u> There after no changes are possible anymore.

The competition will take place in a 10 lanes 50 meter pool with electronic time registration, so please <u>leave the pool at the sites</u>.

For the description of the disciplines see the latest version of the ILS Competition Rule Book.

AWARDS / Competition

The awards for the Orange Cup are as follows:

- For the individual disciplines there will be medals for the categories, junior / senior / master (30-39, 40-49 and 50+) for both group's women and men.
- For the Orange Cup (team competition), the results of the relays are based on the 20points ILS table.
- The Orange Cup is based on one club team for women, men and total (so no deviation to junior/senior/master).

The competition for the Dutch Championship is only open for Dutch competitors. The medals are in the same categories as the International Competition.
