DECLARATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 3 (ELIGIBILITY AND RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE) OF THE ILS 2018 LIFESAVING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS COMPETITION HANDBOOK-	14

0. Aim

Aim of the competition is the qualification for the national team for the World Championships in 2018.

Beside the squad athletes particularly young athletes shall get the possibility to achieve classification.

The competition offers to participants from 15 years (age group 2003 and older) an additional opportunity to prove their achievement at a national level with an international character, especially on the single events.

Because of the cancellation of the German Cup in 2018, we decided to offer this competition to all participants inside ILS.

The English version of the announcement is addressing the world wide lifesaving community. However in case of discrepancies the German version shall prevail.

1. Organiser, Host, Date, Place

This Announcement is based on the ILS- Competition Rulebook and the national DLRG „Rulebook Lifesaving Sports– Pool Events“(Details see 3.1).

2 Registration

2.1. Registration Portal

Participants shall register exclusively via the registration portal on the DLRG homepage

www.dlrg.de/sport

The application to the event shall be submitted by the respective club or lifesaving unit.

The team members shall comply with section *3.3 Interclub Lifesaving World Championships* of the *ILS_2018__World_Championships_Compition_Handbook_-_Oct_17_1* and the adaptations as follows:

The DLRG-Cup Pool is open to individuals and teams from clubs or lifesaving units. All team members must be in good standing with a current ILS Full Membership. To be eligible to compete in the DLRG-Cup Pool, competitors shall:

- Be bona fide lifesavers and members in good standing of a current ILS Full Member, and currently qualified for lifesaving duties.
- Have been members of their team's national lifesaving organisation for at least 90 days prior to the first day of the DLRG-Cup Pool (i.e. 24 June 2018).
- Be members of one lifesaving club, or lifesaving "unit" of a national lifesaving organisation and not from multiple clubs or units.
- Attain the required age of 15 years in 2018 or are even older.

Definition of a club for the DLRG-Cup Pool: Competitors entered as a club must be members of the same club or "lifesaving unit". The definition of a club – for national lifesaving organisations that do not have a club system – is: The basic administrative or lifesaving unit of the lifesaving organisation (not an amalgam of such units); such unit having a constitution and having representation to a higher body.

For entry into the DLRG-Cup Pool, national lifesaving organisations shall provide an endorsement declaring that competitors meet the eligibility requirements listed above. The clubs are requested to send this endorsement as PDF or JPG to

not later than the official registration deadline. A template is amended at the end of this announcement.

Both participants for the line throw event must be nominated through the registration portal not later than the registration deadline.

2.2. Registration Deadline

Official Deadline

19.08.2018

At the end of the registration deadline all data will be processed and transferred into other systems to prepare the registration lists and seedings of the events.

Changes entered after that date will not be considered.

Registration lists will be published up to 27.08.2018. Thereafter clubs may correct registration errors by sending a free text mail not later than 02.09.2018 to

The mail should be indicating with the subject

Applications and changes of applications after the official deadline won't be considered. Replacements of participants on short notice prior to the competition start will not be accepted.

2.3. Age Class

All participants from age group 2003 and older will start in the open age class and will be classified separate in male and female.

2.4. Events

A) Single Events referring to ILS Rulebook

- 200m Obstacle Swim
- 100m Manikin Tow with Fins
- 100m Rescue Medley
- 100m Manikin Carry with Fins
- 50m Manikin Carry
- 200m Super Lifesaver

B) Team events referring to ILS Rulebook

- Line Throw

C) Special offered team events referring to ILS Rulebook

- 50m Obstacle Swim,
this corresponds to the first leg of the Obstacle Relay – 4 x 50 m
- 25m Manikin Carry,
this corresponds to the first leg of the Manikin Relay – 4 x 25 m
- 50m Manikin Carry
this corresponds to the third leg of the Pool Lifesaver Relay – 4 x 50 m.
the competitor starts in the water holding a manikin at the surface with one hand and the pool edge or starting block with the other hand.
- 50m Manikin Carry with Fins
this corresponds to the fourth leg of the Pool Lifesaver Relay – 4 x 50 m
the competitor starts in the water holding a manikin at the surface with one hand and the pool edge or starting block with the other hand.
- 50m Freestyle with Fins
this corresponds to the second leg of the Medley Relay – 4 x 50m

The events of group A will have heats and an A-final. The events of group B) and C) will be conducted as heats without finals.

Each competitor can participate only once per event.

3. Rulebook, eligibility and entry procedures

3.1. Rulebook

The DCP 2018 is performed in accordance with the *ILS Competition Rulebook (2015-2019 Edition Revised 2017)*.

In case an update will be published by ILS prior to the DCP2018 this update will be considered.

In case of discrepancies between the ILS Competition Rulebook and this announcement the latter shall prevail.

3.2. Eligibility

All competitors must meet the entry times as detailed in section 3.3. Here, results achieved since 01.01.2017 at national or international official competitions conducted in a 50m pool may be considered.

Result lists / recordings have to provide evidence on competition type, organizer and host, venue and pool dimensions, and preferably chief referee and staff.

The organizing committee assumes, that all registration entries are fairly reported and will not check the eligibility to compete in advance.

However, if entry times are not met in the heats, the competitor will be sanctioned with an increased entry fee (IEF) as detailed in section 3.4

3.4. Increased Entry Fee (IEF)

An increased entry fee of additionally 50 € becomes due for each heat, where a competitor did not meet the required entry times (3.3).

The IEF applies as well for competitors who were disqualified, did not finish or did not start.

The IEF also becomes due if a competitor does not appear to a final without checking out not later than 30 minutes after nomination for the finals. The official publishing time of the results for the particular event is being considered.

The IEF has to be paid immediately on the organizers request at the pool area. If the IEF is not paid, the organiser can refuse the continuance of the competition to all competitors from the respective club.

The IEF does not apply, if the club can provide evidence that the required entry time was achieved in a competition without disqualification by means of a result list / recording as detailed in section 3.2

In case of a withdrawal from a race 30 minutes prior to the start of the first heat the IEF is not due.

3.5. Other regulations

The international ILS Rulebook requires all competitors and assistants to wear a cap and describes the allowed swim dress, which is also defined in the national Rulebook

Details can be found in the Information Sheet E9-001 Rules concerning swim dress at lifesaving competitions of DLRG.

Because of security reasons we point out:

- Information Sheet M3-001 – swimming and diving with goggles.
- Information Sheet M3-002 – self declaration of health condition

4. Competition

4.1. Registration on location

Central venue is the Georg-Leber Kaserne in Warendorf.

A registration of the competitors on location is not necessary.

Ordered meal vouchers are handed out in the morning (forenoon) of the first day of competition at the pool.

4.2. Membership documents

For non DLRG participants eligibility will be confirmed in advance by an endorsement of the respective national ILS federation.

The organizer reserves the right to check the identity of the participants by means of an identity card or passport.

The discipline **25m Manikin Carry** will probably be carried out in the 25m pool (5 lanes with 25m length, ca. 27°C temperature, water depth 1,80m)

The organiser reserves the right to change the pool for this event on short notice. In case of a performance on the 50m- lane the finish will be in the middle of the pool.

The discipline **Line Throw** will be carried out on all 8 lanes. Platforms will not be provided.

Manual time keeping is applied for the discipline *25m Manikin Carry*
All other events will be recorded by electronic timing.

The pool is equipped with a wardrobe which can be used by giving 2,- € pledge.

4.4. Material

The following equipment will be set by the organiser and has to be used by the competitors:

- Rescue tube
- Obstacles
- Manikins
- Lines

4.5. Results

Interim and final results will be published near the pool. Protests must be lodged within 15 minutes of the posting of the results.

4.6. Award Ceremony

The Award Ceremony will take place immediately after the respective final in the pool area, respectively immediately at the end of the competition on Sunday afternoon.

4.7. Officials

The invitation of the officials will be handled with a separate Circular.

4.8. Time Schedule

The sequence of events will be based on the schedule of the World Championships 2018. A provisional time schedule will be distributed not later than 4 weeks before deadline. All news can be downloaded at the link:

4.9. Doping Controls

The National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) will determine Doping tests according to their guidelines.

Competitors, who are selected for a doping control, will be notified by a NADA delegate during the competition. They have to appear to the doping control within a certain time period.

In case a competitor misses to appear to the control within the defined period, this is considered as a breach of anti-doping-regulations and will lead to disqualification.

5. Costs

a) Entry fee

The entry fee for each competitor is 10, 00 € per event.

If the competitor applies for more than 6 events, the fee is limited to 60, 00 €.

Apart from that the entry fee for the *Line Throw* event is 10,00€ for the team.

b) Increased entry fee (IEF)

The increased entry fee is 50, 00 €, see chapter 3.4

c) Costs for board and lodging

Each participating delegation cares for board and lodging itself.
